

ORDINANCE No. 9132005

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING FIVE (5) MEMBER BOARD
FOR THE TOWN OF COOPERSTOWN**

The Town of Cooperstown Board of Supervisors do ordain that the following ordinance is hereby created to create a five (5) member Board within the Town as follows:

As directed by the Town Board pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.21(1), the Town Board of the Town of Cooperstown is hereby increased from a three (3) member Board of Supervisors to a five (5) member Board of Supervisors consisting of the Town Board Chairperson and four (4) Town Board Supervisors.

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.21(1), the Town shall elect three (3) Supervisors in odd-numbered years and two (2) Supervisors in even-numbered years.

An increase in the number of Town Board Supervisors pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.21(1) does not create a vacancy on the Town Board prior to the April 4, 2006 election.

This Ordinance was passed by a vote of 2 by the Town Board of Supervisors at the meeting of said Town Board of the Town of Cooperstown, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, held at the Town Hall on the 11 day of October, 2005.


